**1. RULES & ANNOUNCEMENTS** 

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.

**1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.** 

**1.3** This event is designated a Clean Regatta by the Sailors for the Sea Organization, <u>http://www.sailorsforthesea.org/</u>, a nonprofit organization that educates and empowers boaters to protect and restore our oceans and coastal waters. Single-use plastics including water bottles will not be allowed. HYC and the OA is committed to sustainability and limiting waste.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to One-Design classes under 25'.
